

GOVERNMENT CAMP SANITARY DISTRICT

Sole Source Procurement of Replacement UV Disinfection Equipment

WHEREAS, the Government Camp Sanitary District (“District”) operates a wastewater treatment plant (“Plant”); and

WHEREAS, the Plant’s disinfection system has been in continuous operation for more than 23 years and requires replacement parts to address certain system failures and ensure proper continued operation; and

WHEREAS, the District’s engineer of record, Curt McLeod of Curran-McLeod, Inc., has recommended replacement of the plant’s UV Disinfection equipment (“Equipment”), which in order to be compatible with the current disinfection system can only be procured from the original manufacturer, Trojan Technologies; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) 279B.075 allows a contracting agency to award a contract for goods or services without competition when the local contract review board determines in writing that the goods or services are available from only one source, and bases this determination on written findings that the efficient utilization of existing goods requires acquiring compatible goods or services;

WHEREAS, written findings justifying the use of a sole-source vendor for the Equipment are provided in Exhibit A to this resolution, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, a written quote for the cost of the Equipment is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS the District on January 10, 2024 published in the Sandy Post a notification of intent to authorize a sole-source procurement for the Equipment from Trojan Technologies at 3020 Gore Road, London, Ontario, Canada; and


WHEREAS no protests were filed with the District in the time allotted per the statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


1. The Board of Directors, acting as the District’s Local Contract Review Board (“LCRB”), hereby adopts the findings stated Exhibit A to this Resolution in support of a sole-source procurement.
2. For the reasons stated in the written findings, the LCRB hereby approves the purchase of UV Disinfection Equipment from Trojan Technologies as a sole-source procurement, without competitive bidding.
3. To the extent reasonably practical, the District shall negotiate with Trojan Technologies to obtain the best price for the Equipment, but in no event shall the cost for the Equipment exceed the amount stated in Exhibit B without further action of the Board.
