IN THE MATTER OF THE FORMATION
OF GOVERNMENT CAMP SANITARY DISTRICT

ORDER 1512

WHEREAS at an election duly and regularly held on the 22nd day of May, 1953, within that portion of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, described as,

All of Lot 4 in Section 14 and the North One-half of Section 23, Township 3 South, Range 8 1/2 East of the Willamette Meridian, also the North-east One-quarter of Section 24, Township 3 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian,

THERE WAS SUBMITTED to the legal voters thereof the question whether all that portion of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, as above described shall be formed into a Sanitary District as provided in Chapter 378, Oregon Laws of 1949; and

WHEREAS at such election so held 51 votes were cast in favor of such formation of said Sanitary District and 0 (no) votes were cast against such formation; and

WHEREAS the formation of such Sanitary District received the affirmative vote of the majority votes cast at such election;

NOW THEREFORE, the County Court or Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, does hereby proclaim and declare all that part of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, herein before described has been duly and legally formed into a Sanitary District under the name of GOVERNMENT CAMP SANITARY DISTRICT; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election show, that the following are all the votes cast for each candidate for the office of directors, to-wit:

- Everett L. Darr 28 votes
- Raymond M. Hughes 28 votes
- Ole Langerud 27 votes

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the three persons receiving all votes cast at said election, for the office of directors of said district are hereby declared elected to said office of Director and the County Clerk is hereby directed to issue certificates of election to said directors.

THIS MATTER COMING before the Court at
this time and it appearing to the Court that a petition accompanied by a cash
bond approved by the Court and signed by 25 resident freeholders of the pro-
posed Government Camp Sanitary District, has been presented to the Court to hold
an election to establish a Sanitary District in the Government Camp, Clackamas
County, Oregon, area; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that notices of
hearing were properly posted and published as provided for in Chapter 378, O.L.
1949, and that said hearing was held on November 24th, 1952, at 10:00 o'clock a.m.
at Oregon City, Oregon by the County Court in regular session; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the Court has
approved the petition for the formation of the proposed Government Camp Sanitary
District and has set the date on which the election will be held in the proposed
district; now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an election be
held on April 14th, 1953, at Government Camp, Clackamas County, Oregon, between
the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., at the Government Camp Village Store, on
Highway No. 26, located one block from the Post Office, for the purpose of voting
upon the following described proposed sanitary district and the election of three
members of the Sanitary Board:

All of Lot 4 in Section 14 and the North one-half of Section 23,
Township 3 South, Range 8, East of the Willamette Meridian, also
the Northeast one-quarter of Section 24, Township 3 South, Range 8
East of the Willamette Meridian.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County
Clerk have published a copy of this order in the Sandy Post of Sandy, Oregon, once
a week for four successive weeks prior to the election date and caused to be posted
a copy of said order in three public places within the proposed district prior
to the date of election. Ballots to be prepared in accordance with Chapter 378,
S.L. 1949.
